GRAMMAR:

SUPERSTAR AND REPORTER

Course/level: UKR 211

Objective:

The students will learn some new functions of the Gen. case in Ukrainian (after negation, after a group of verbs, after prepositions, in proper names) and will be able to use the appropriate noun endings in the phrases requiring the use of the Gen. case.

Prerequisites:

- Nom. and Acc. cases
- Other cases general
- 4 groups of nouns

Materials & Equipment:

- Two types of cards:
 - a) "reporter's notebook"
 - b) "superstar's notebook"
- Whiteboard, colourful markers
- Pictures of Ukrainian celebrities

Process/Instructions:

- 1) The instructor shows several photos of Ukrainian superstars and celebrities and then asks the students alternative ("or") questions. Both questions and answers contain the Gen. case.
- 2) The instructor writes several answers on the whiteboard. The endings of the Gen. case are highlighted.
- 3) The students are divided into pairs and the instructor explains that in every pair there will be a superstar (*cynepsipκa*) and a reporter. The reporter should get the necessary information for his report in the local newspaper. The superstar will ask questions too.
- 4) One partner in each pair takes a card randomly. Then those without cards get one from the instructor to form pairs: superstar + reporter.
- 5) Students work in pairs. After this "reporters" present their reports to the whole group and the "superstars" share information about the reporter.

Adaptation:

- Best for teenagers; 20s, 30s + mixed-age groups;
- Can be used with different grammatical cases.

Conclusion:

This activity allowed students to learn the hard material by participating in a game-like activity with the focus on developing conversation skills in Ukrainian.

Cases in Ukrainian

To know the ending

- 1) determine GENDER
- 2) determine DECLENSION TYPE
- 3) determine NUMBER

No	Name	Question	Singular	Plural
1	Nominative - Називний	хто? що?	баб-а	баб-и
2	Genitive - Родовий	кого? чого?	баб-и	баб
3	Dative - Давальний	кому? чому?	баб-і	баб-ам
4	Accusative - Знахідний	кого? що?	баб-у	баб
5	Instrumental - Орудний	ким? чим?	баб-ою	баб-ами
6	Locative - Місцевий	на кому? на чому?	на баб-і	на баб-ах

These groups of words remain unchangeable in all cases:

- 1. Foreign words ending in a vowel: меню, кіно, пальто;
- 2. Feminine surnames ending in a consonant or -o: Шевченко;
- 3. Russian surnames ending in -ово, -аго, -их: Іваново, Галуцьких;
- 4. Abbreviations: ООН, США, СНД (exceptions: вузу, ЛАЗом);
- 5. Abbreviations formed from 2 roots: завкафедри (завідуючий+кафедри).
